Thank you for participating in the 2019 UCOWR/NIWR Conference being held June 11-13 at Snowbird, Utah.

The maximum size for posters is:

44 inches tall x 40 inches wide and MUST be PORTRAIT orientation.

Posters will be on display Tuesday morning through Thursday morning (if you check in on Monday, you may put your poster up at that time). Please remove your poster no later than Thursday morning by 11:00 am. Any poster that is not removed by this time will be recycled. The poster session will be **Tuesday, June 11, 5:30 - 7:00 p.m.** in conjunction with the Welcome Reception.

STUDENT POSTERS will be judged and monetary awards will be given for First (\$400), Second (\$200), and Third (\$100) place at the UCOWR Awards Luncheon on Wednesday, June 12. See page 2 for the poster judging criteria. **Students must stand by their poster during the poster session to field questions by judges.** (*Once the judges have reviewed your poster, feel free to get yourself something to eat.*)

When you check in at the conference, let us know you have a poster. You will be given fasteners to attach your poster to the board. You will also be given a number; locate the same number on the display boards and put your poster in that spot.
