**Position Summary:** The Forestry Program in the School of Agricultural Sciences at Southern Illinois University Carbondale seeks applicants for a full-time, 9-month, tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor, effective January 1, 2021. The new faculty member will collaborate with SIU Forestry colleagues as well as synergize with scientists in the College of Agricultural, Life, and Physical Sciences and others across the university. The new faculty member will contribute to teaching undergraduate and graduate Forestry students across programmatic specializations.

- 1. Ph.D. in Forestry, Natural Resources, Water Resources, Wildlife, Fisheries, or another closely related field by the effective date of hire. ABD applicants will be considered if all requirements for the PhD degree will be completed by December 31, 2020. **Preferred Qualifications:** Preference will be given to candidates with a B.S. in Forestry from an SAF accredited university. Record of publications in refereed journals and securing of external research grants is also preferred.
